Is your sophomore or junior ready for the upcoming year of English?

High school students are expected to read and respond to difficult texts by writing essays and short answer responses. In these written assessments, students must provide insightful commentary, show their stylistic maturity with concise and elevated word choice, and organize their ideas in a logical and sophisticated manner. A strong foundation of writing skills is imperative for success and achievement in high school and beyond.

Is your child struggling to write clearly and effectively? The focus on state tests has left kids with a very formulaic writing style and has hindered the basic writing process. As a result, many kids do not understand how to transfer their writing skills to real-world applications. This leaves parents frustrated and students overwhelmed by the demands and expectations of an advanced writing curriculum.

This Writing Workshop will help your child find his/her own writing style.

As a way to strengthen the writing of sophomores and juniors, I am offering a summer writing workshop based on the principles of writing that have been shown to be effective for decades.

This Writing Workshop will focus on:

- A Strong Foundation: Getting and Organizing Ideas, Thesis and Topic Statements
- Beat the Clock: Top-Scoring Essays in Timed Situations
- High-Stakes Tests: Writing for the STAAR and SAT assessments
- Tricking Out Your Essay: Simple Techniques to Get Your Essay Noticed

Students will be guided through the foundational elements of the writing process so that they understand the steps and techniques of effective writing. Students will participate in mini-lessons on specific content and editing strategies.

Models of effective writing will be shown, discussed, and imitated. Time for drafting and revising, peer response, and teacher conferencing will also be incorporated in every session. This writing workshop will encourage young writers to discover their own style, voice, and potential, ultimately, helping students grow and build self confidence in their writing abilities.

As the English department chair at Carroll High School, Karen is familiar with the rigors and expectations of the English courses in Carroll ISD. Her experience in the classroom (fifteen years and counting), MA in English, and extensive knowledge of the writing process have taught her that all students can write if they are just given the tools to do so. In Karen's presentations at state-level conferences and as a consultant for districts in the DFW, San Antonio, and Waco areas, she has helped other teachers learn how to successfully improve their students' writing.
