Beginning Keyboarding- Using the keyboard is a life skill that all students need to know. Students will need to type papers, projects, and many other things by the time they are in fifth grade. This is a fun way for your child to learn their home row keys and more. (Grades 3, 4, 5)

AM Session: Beginner Bots - Students will be building Sumo Robots. This is a beginner course for those students who would like to explore NXT LEGO robotics. Students will see which robot can push out their opponent's robot. (Grades 3, 4, 5, 6)

PM Session: Design Squad - This session involves inventions and building with recycled objects. Creative thinking must involve hands-on work and if you like to build, this class is for you! Come join us as we build zip lines, vehicles, mouse traps, and others. (Grades 1, 2, 3, 4)

AM Session: Movie Madness – (iPad, ITouch, iPhone with a camera and iMovie, My Create, Puppet Pals(Directors Pass), and Animator for Kids apps are needed to join this camp). This session will teach students how to write, direct, act and film a movie. This is great way to teach your child that an iPad is not a gaming device but a creativity tool. (Grades 2,3, 4, 5)
